

## **STUDENT DRIVING/PARKING REGULATIONS**

1. You, or any person using the parking tag will lose your parking privileges and be subject to school disciplinary action and/or possible citation, arrest or removal of your vehicle by **TOWING AT YOUR EXPENSE** if:
  - You drive in a careless or dangerous manner.
  - You fail to report an accident or damage to another vehicle or property.
  - You use an unregistered vehicle.
  - You drive without your parent or guardian's written consent.
  - You park in non-designated areas such as no parking zones, walkways, handicapped, staff lot, maintenance, in aisles, on yellow lines, in driveways.
  - Your parking tag is not on display as designated below.
  - You possess alcoholic beverages and/or drugs in or about the vehicle.
  - You possess a weapon in your vehicle.
2. Parking tickets can **NOT** be voided. You must have your tags displayed with the print facing out from the rear view mirror without any distractions at all times.
3. Parents may revoke their son's or daughter's parking privilege at any time by notifying an administrator or the police consultant (fees forfeited for the current semester).
4. Students may park only in the East parking lot (Plum Grove and Cougar Trail).
5. The student parking tag may only be used among vehicles whose license numbers are listed on the application. The parking tag may **NOT** be sold, traded, or loaned to other students. Violating this policy will result in an immediate loss of parking privileges.
6. Students enrolled in a credit course for which District 211 **DOES NOT** provide transportation will qualify for a parking tag at a cost of \$65. Per semester. An application must be completed and submitted by the due date.
7. Students may not loiter or smoke in vehicles on school property.
8. James B. Conant High School and District 211 are not liable for any damage, theft, injury or death that may occur as a result of a person driving to school or parking on school property. To keep your belongings secure, lock your vehicle at all times.
9. Students who use any vehicle to violate any school regulation, village ordinance, state law, or federal law shall lose their school driving privileges.
10. Students planning to drive a different car to school must report to their Team Room with the license, make, and model of the new vehicle.
11. Replacement tags are available for \$20.00. To keep your parking tag secure, lock your vehicle at all times. If the tag is mutilated or unusable it may be brought to your Team Room for a replacement. Refunds will not be issued.
12. Students who withdraw from school must surrender their parking tag and forfeit fees for the current semester before transcripts will be issued.
13. The use of cell phones (texting, phone conversations, and e-mailing) is prohibited while driving on campus. Hoffman Estates Police will issue tickets to any violating this policy.
14. Parking privileges may be suspended or revoked at the discretion of administration, without refund, for disciplinary infractions. Including, but not limited to truancies, suspensions, and/or excessive tardies.
15. Students must enroll in the "Operation Click" program which is a seatbelt enforcement program. Click It or Ticket!! For more information, visit [www.operationclick.org](http://www.operationclick.org).
16. Automobiles may be searched by authority of principalship and when there is reason to believe there are illegal and/or harmful materials in an automobile.
17. All students, and students who possess a valid Conceal and Carry license may not store or carry a weapon on any District 211 property.
18. Students with 10 or more tardies in a semester and/or have issues with truancies will have their permit revoked without refund.
