

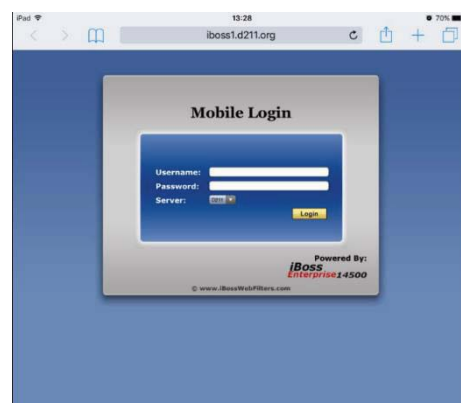
School-Assigned iPad: Accessing the Internet While Away From School

When students are using their school-assigned iPad on campus, Conant High School uses an Internet content filter to block access to websites deemed unsuitable for school. Effective March 20, 2017 the school's Internet content filter will be applied to your iPad when you access the Internet while away from school, for example at your home or when you use a public Wi-Fi network.

Called iBoss, the Internet content filter will be active whenever you log onto a Wi-Fi network while outside of the school. You will need to log in to the iBoss filter to access the Internet with your school-assigned iPad. This applies to web browsers, such as Safari and Chrome, email apps, and other apps that require an Internet connection including Schoology and Infinite Campus.

Here are the steps you will need to follow to access the Internet when away from school with your school-assigned iPad.

- 1) Open up a new tab in your internet browser, such as Safari or Chrome. The iBoss login screen will appear. If it does not appear, you will need to restart your iPad.



- 2) Sign into the iBoss login using your school username and password. Example below:
 - a. Username: lastname+4digits
 - b. Password: 6 Digit ID#



- You will need to sign in **every time you connect to the Internet** in a new place for the first time.
- You may need to sign in to use the Internet multiple times in the same place depending on how the Internet works at that location (such as at a library or if you are using a hot spot at home to connect).
- The filter will reset every eight (8) hours. You will need to sign in each time you connect to a new Wi-Fi and/or every eight (8) hours on a known Wi-Fi network when you want to connect to the Internet outside of school.
